Town Manager/Island Operations Director Comments

It's great to see the island come to life again. Here are a few notes as we enter week 3:

Eric Berube: Frye Island was a big part of Eric's life, and the presence of so many islanders at the celebration of life last Saturday in Oxford and the gratifying response to our GoFundMe page are strong evidence of the place he held in our community. At the suggestion of many islanders and the request of Eric's family we are planning a memorial event on Frye Island to celebrate Eric's life and contributions. At this time, the date has not been determined. A small group of volunteers to help plan and organize the event would be welcome.

Mail Forwarding: Another reminder that this year, your Frye Island postal address will be your E-911 street address NOT your lot number. The post office will crossmatch addresses for a limited period, but this practice will come to an end soon.

Post Office Boxes: To be sure P.O. boxes are assigned correctly, please confirm your box number with the office.

Boat Slips: Another notice to pay your slip fees if you haven't done it, to avoid losing your slip to someone on the waiting list. In the interest of getting slip assignments worked out before Memorial Day in the future, the end of the grace period will very likely move back next year. It's a good idea to get the payment made promptly.

Directory Information and Email Addresses: As we get underway for another season, please make sure your information is up to date. We need to be sure we can contact you reliably when needed. Also, please make sure your spam filter is set to accept town-wide email notifications.

Paddock Circle Trailer Park: The trailer parking area on Paddock Circle has been upgraded and is now re-opened. Please remember that this is for seasonal use only while boats are in the water. All trailers must be removed in the fall for routine maintenance. Also please be considerate of others, and label your trailer with your lot number and name, in case you need to be contacted.

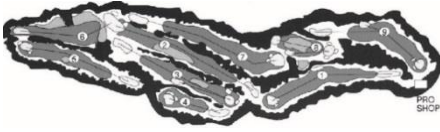
