Well it does seem as if spring has indeed sprung, with temps staying in the 70's. Good news! Now if we could only get the rain to stay away for a while. It would be good to dry out!

As I mentioned last week, we launched a new website recently. And we are getting a nice number of page views with over 100 visits a day this week. The information continues to be updated and I anticipate that it will all be current and accurate as of entering the high season for us on June 20. Take a moment and check it out at www.fryesleap.com. While you are there, sign up to be a VIP and get on our mailing list for notification of specials and receive coupons!

Now that the warmer weather is here and if you are thinking about planting some more flowers or herbs in your garden, we recently received a second delivery of plants so our selection has increased. We also have organic potting soil in 1 CU FT bags if you need some soil treatment for your plants. And if you would like to add some color to your garden, we have a number of wind spinners in stock. As I mentioned last week, we have a new shipment of signs for decorating your camps. We have them spread out around the store and hardware area so take a peek when you are next visiting us. And we even added a few more new shirts and sweatshirts to our display and inventory. Everything is just about in for the season now.

This is the last weekend of reduced hours for the café where we are open only on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. As well, this will be the last weekend of our smaller menu that is a subset of what we will be offering during the high season. Then once we are open daily effective June 20th, we will launch the full menu. In the bar we have a full selection of cold beverages for your refreshment. We are pouring 15 different draft beers/ciders and 18 different wines. Something to wet your whistle as we continue to move through spring towards summer. Looking ahead to the high season, our first tap takeover has been scheduled. We will be pouring beer with Lone Pine on Saturday July 13. If you are a Lone Pine Oh-J fan, be sure to mark the day on your calendar! Several other tap takeovers are in the planning stages.

As we start the high season on Frye Island, please remember to replace the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors! The best practice is to replace the batteries at the start of every season to be sure the detectors sound the alarm if you need them.

ALWAYS USE YOUR E-911 ADDRESS WHEN CALLING 911 FOR ASSISTANCE.

This is the number on the metal pole installed by the town near your driveway and on the refrigerator magnet distributed by the town. Having the correct address is crucial to getting emergency services personnel to your home quickly. It applies to all emergencies, whether fire, medical or police. Please provide this number to any guests and renters who may use your property. Thanks, and have a great season!

- 1. You must have a driver's license in either Maine or your home state to operate a motor vehicle on Frye Island. This includes golf carts, cars, motor cycles and yes UTV's. If you have a youthful appearance and I pull you over, you must produce a valid driver's license.
- 2. Adults: You may not operate a motor vehicle in the state of Maine with an open container of alcohol. Failure to comply will result in a motor vehicle violation. A ticket for clarification.
- 3. Fireworks are illegal on Frye Island.
